Planned Parenthood is already the nation's largest abortion chain. Even as abortion rates drop, Planned Parenthood's abortion business is increasing. They perform over 327,000 abortions every year, and half their clinic income is from abortion. Now they're trying to squeeze even more profit out of these abortions.
